Entry Package

Show Rules- All exhibitors must read & understand these rules.

1. No exhibitor shall knowingly enter a bird recently vaccinated, within 30 days, or even exposed to any communicable disease. All birds entering the building must be clean and healthy or they will be rejected without refund of fees.
2. This show is sanctioned by the American Poultry Association (APA) and the American Bantam Association (ABA).
3. No exhibitor shall fake, show borrowed birds, or engage in flagrant misconduct. Exhibitors caught will be stripped of prizes, awards and points awarded in all classes at the show.
4. **Exhibitors must be a member in good standing of the Fraser Valley Poultry Fanciers Association, Cowichan Feather Fanciers, or Vernon Pigeon & Poultry club.**
5. Any complaints must be made in writing to the Show Chairman as soon as possible with a \$25.00 deposit. The show committee, made up of the Show Chairman, two others and the APA judge, shall make the final decision. If the panel finds in favour of the complaint, the \$25.00 will be returned to the complainant, if not, it will be forfeited to the F.V.P.F.A.
6. All entry fees are payable to the F.V.P.F.A. Please do not send cash in the mail. Please send your form completed to the address indicated on it.
7. Entry forms must be *received* by the Show Chairman by **April 25, 2019, 4:00pm.**
8. Entry fees are \$2.50 per bird. **There is a \$5.00 Exhibitor Fee for all non-junior exhibitors. Junior exhibitors are not required to pay this fee.**
9. All birds must have been owned by, and in the possession of, the exhibitor for 30 days prior to the first day of the show. Junior entries must be cared for by the exhibiting junior.
10. Coop-in will occur between 8:30-9:30 am, Sunday, May 5, 2019. Judging will begin at 10:00 am sharp on May 5, 2019.
11. **Coop out will begin no sooner than 3:00 pm, Sunday, May 5, 2019.**
12. Birds entered and not shown will forfeit their entry fees to the FVPFA. Substitutions of another breed will be treated as additional entries and subject to additional fees. Absolutely no one is allowed to mark coop cards without permission of the Show Chairman.
13. Absolutely no one is to handle any exhibit but their own, except show management & judges. Rows will be closed during judging and may only be entered by clerks, judges and show management. **Exhibitors inside a closed row will be considered tampering and treated as cheating.**
14. All eggs laid during the show will be destroyed.
15. Any bird entered as a young bird (eg. Cockerel or Pullet), must be less than 1-year-old at the time of the show. Any birds over 1-year-old are considered mature and must be entered as Cock or Hen.
16. The latest issue of the APA Standard of Perfection and ABA Standard will be the guide used by judges for awarding prizes and classifying entries. Other comparable standards will be used for respective fowl.
17. Birds entered by junior exhibitors will compete in the open show in all classes.
18. The show committee, on behalf of the FVPFA, will take all precautions necessary to ensure the safety and well-being of entries, but in no way will be liable for death, injury or theft of same.
19. Any matter not provided for in these rules or the rules for APA and ABA sanctioned shows shall be at the discretion of the show committee, their decision shall be final.

FVPFA Egg Show Rules

1. Eggs must have been produced by birds within the exhibitor's flock, from the breeds specified
2. Eggs are to be fresh and exhibited in groups of 3 on plates provided by the FVPFA.
3. Eggs must be entered according to the classes below:
 - a. Large Eggs (originating from large fowl chickens)
 - i. Specify recognized breed, or non-standard and colour (on entry form)
 - b. Bantam Eggs
 - i. Specify recognized breed, or non-standard and colour (on entry form)
 - c. Waterfowl Eggs
 - i. Specify recognized breed, or non-standard and colour (on entry form)
 - d. Any Other Eggs
 - i. Specify species on entry form.
 - e. Decorated Eggs
 - i. Entry must be blown or hard-boiled
 - ii. Eggs may be painted or adorned with accessories.
 - iii. Eggs must maintain their original shape and outline.
 - iv. Eggs must have been prepared solely by the exhibitor.
4. Limit of one entry per class per exhibitor.
5. Eggs will be judged based on the proposed egg judging guidelines administered by the American Poultry Association. This standard can be found [here](#).
6. All egg entries will become the property of the FVPFA, except for Decorated Eggs. All eggs entered in specified classes 3.a. to 3.d. above will be destroyed at the end of the show.
7. Awards will be provided as follows:
 - a. Best in Class
 - b. Reserve in Class
 - c. Best Egg Entry
 - d. Reserve Egg Entry
 - e. Best Junior Egg Entry
 - f. Reserve Junior Egg Entry
8. Entries must be received by the published entry deadline on the entry form provided. Please use the same entry form and indicate "Egg" in the Sex column.
